Description:

Due to the implementation of a strictly target-oriented steering mechanism of administration management in Austria all public sector entities are obliged to define concrete and precise targets in order to facilitate the evaluation of the outcome of the invested budget. For this purpose these targets have to meet the main challenges of the respective entity and shall allow long-time comparison of developments respectively achievements.

Combatting violence is one of the main targets of the Austrian Federal Ministry of the Interior. The project team was asked to define key figures complying with these guidelines. The final report formulates such key figures based upon the anti-violence-impact factors “restraining and protection orders” (“Betretungsverbote”) and the ratio of reported to the non-reported violent crimes.
