Description:

In the event of a crisis or disaster, rapid action is a critical factor in keeping the impact low and preventing further damage. For a timely assessment of the situation, social media, instant messaging services and similar forms and channels of communication offer an opportunity for real-time and bi-directional information exchange with affected persons on site. Within the framework of the iLiKe project, a service is therefore being designed which, on the one hand, makes it possible to make open data sources and channels usable for the emergency organizations and, on the other, to meet the information needs of the inhomogeneous population quickly and reliably.

ALES-Austrian Center for Law Enforcement Sciences is supporting the project to ensure compliance with legal regulations. In this regard, the main focus is on regular briefings of the other project partners and the drafting of legal statements.
